BRING FAIR PHONE RATES TO ESSEX COUNTY JAIL!

▶▶▶ Essex County's contract for telephone services at Essex County Jail puts profits ahead of families and public safety. Phone rates up to 17 times higher than prevailing rates fill Essex County government pockets to the tune of nearly 11 million per year at the expense of those who can least afford it.



EXORBITANT PHONE RATES

Under the current calling plan selected by the County, a fifteen-minute call from Essex County Jail costs up to:

- \$1.75 to Newark and other nearby municipalities.
- \$4.20 to the rest of North Jersey.
- \$5.70 to other parts of New Jersey.
- \$12.85 to New York City!

Essex County Jail phone rates represent a 543% markup over recently obtained estimates of residential phone cots, and a whopping **1,713% markup** to call out of state.

PURE PROFIT

Under Essex County's calling plan, the County retains <u>a 54% "commission"</u> on <u>every phone call made by inmates and detainees</u>. The remaining portion of every phone call goes to Global Tel*Link, a private company.

Last year, Essex County siphoned almost a million dollars out of Essex County jail phone fees, and is budgeted to take a similar amount this year.

Essex/GTL \$1.7 million per year

The remaining fees go to Global Tel*Link ("GTL"), a private company which charges prisoners in New York a mere five cents per minute for long-distance phone calls. In regulatory filings, Global Tel*Link has been willing to offer undisclosed discounts on phone rates, should correctional facilities merely ask.
